

3772-19-08 Surveillance retention.

(A) All recordings of coverage, including audio recordings, must be retained for a minimum of thirty days.

(B) Recordings of detentions and questioning by security personnel must be retained for a minimum of ninety days.

(C) Recordings of activities perceived by casino surveillance employees as unusual, illegal, in violation of Chapter 3772. of the Revised Code or the rules adopted thereunder, or recorded at the request of commission agents must be retained for a minimum of ninety days.

(D) Upon request by any law enforcement agent or commission agent, the casino operator shall retain recordings for a period identified by such law enforcement agent or commission agent.

(E) Each casino operator shall include a retention schedule in its surveillance plan and comply with a procedure for the storage, index and identification of all recordings it is required to retain.

(F) A casino operator shall provide all images and recordings to the commission or its agent upon request. All other law enforcement agencies may obtain images or recordings from a casino operator only upon issuance of a subpoena.

(G) Transfers of photos and recordings from the casino surveillance room shall be tracked, either through electronic or other means, in a manner as approved by the commission.
