

3772-9-08 Movement of electronic gaming equipment within a casino facility.

~~(A) Except when necessary due to a malfunction, a casino operator shall notify the executive director of the commission in writing and receive written approval at least five days before moving electronic gaming equipment within a gaming floor. In the event of a malfunction, the casino operator shall immediately notify the commission of the movement.~~

~~(AB) A casino operator shall maintain a log of all~~All movements, installation, and removal of electronic gaming equipment. ~~The log shall include, but is not limited to:~~shall be recorded in a log that shall be maintained in accordance with the record retention requirements contained in rule of the Administrative Code and include the following:

- (1) The electronic gaming equipment manufacturer's serial number;
- (2) The electronic gaming equipment's asset~~casino operator's equipment~~ number, if applicable;
- (3) The date and time of movement of the equipment;
- (4) The location from which the equipment was moved; and
- (5) The location to which the equipment was moved;

(B) All required logs shall be maintained in accordance with the record retention requirements contained in rule 3772-3-05 of the Administrative Code.

~~(C) Paragraphs (A) and (B) of this rule do not apply to the transportation of electronic gaming equipment to a casino facility when such transportation is done in accordance with rule of the Administrative Code.~~
