

OHIO CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION

RESOLUTION 2012-09

WHEREAS, the Ohio Casino Control Commission (the “Commission”) must complete the functions of licensing, regulating, investigating, and penalizing casino operators, management companies, holding companies, key employees, casino gaming employees, gaming-related vendors, and all other persons participating in or otherwise affecting the integrity of casino gaming in this state;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that:

1. Prior to the initiation of the administrative hearing process, the Commission delegates to the Executive Director the authority to decide when licenses required by Revised Code Chapter 3772 or the rules adopted thereunder should be limited, conditioned, restricted, suspended, revoked, denied, or not renewed, and when persons should be placed on the Commission’s involuntary exclusion list in accordance with Revised Code section 3772.031 and the rules adopted thereunder; and
2. The Commission also delegates to the Executive Director, upon making such decisions, the authority to authorize Commission staff to issue notices of intent and opportunity to be heard to the relevant parties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon completion of the administrative hearing process, each decision will be brought before the Commission for approval, modification, or disapproval.
