OHIO CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION

RESOLUTION 2018-14

DELEGATE AUTHORITY TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO APPROVE MINOR, NON-SUBSTANTIVE, OR IMMATERIAL CHANGES TO INTERNAL CONTROL PLANS

WHEREAS, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission ("Commission");

WHEREAS, R.C. 3772.03(A) authorizes the Commission to ensure the integrity of casino gaming through its regulatory functions;

WHEREAS, R.C. 3772.06 mandates that the Commission appoint an Executive Director who is the Commission's Chief Executive Officer;

WHEREAS, Ohio Adm. Code 3772-2-05 allows the Commission, in its discretion and where permitted by law, to delegate authority to perform functions under R.C. Chapter 3772 to the Executive Director; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered this matter at its public meeting on March 21, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that the Executive Director is delegated the authority to approve minor, non-substantive, or immaterial changes to the casinos' internal control plans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Executive Director determines that a proposed change exceeds this authority, the change must be reviewed and approved by the Commission before implementation.
