

Voluntary Exclusion Program

As of May 19, 2014 the Ohio Casino Control Commission has accepted 936 applications from 11 states and one Canadian province for the voluntary exclusion program. 68 participants have been removed from the program at the expiration of their exclusion period, and 10 have since asked to be reinstated.
