RESOLUTION 2020-48

**ADMINISTRATIVE RULE – ADOPTION & FINAL FILE**

**WHEREAS**, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”);

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 3772.03 requires or authorizes the Commission to adopt administrative rules pursuant to R.C. Chapter 119 to complete the functions stated in R.C. Chapters 3772;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission approved the initial filing of the following six amended administrative rules:

- 3772-10-09 Complimentaries;
- 3772-10-20 Unsecured currency, vouchers, tickets and coupons;
- 3772-10-23 Credit;
- 3772-11-13 Primary, secondary, and reserve sets of gaming chips;
- 3772-11-14 Exchange of value chips or non-value chips; and
- 3772-11-34 Table game layouts;

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with R.C. 106.03, the Commission reviewed these rules to determine, among other things, whether they should be amended and whether they have an adverse impact on business;

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with R.C. 121.82, the Commission evaluated and filed the rules and accompanying Business Impact Analysis with the Common Sense Initiative Office;

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 119.03 sets forth the procedure for filing amended rules;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission followed the rule-filing procedure, providing the agency with the authority to adopt the rules;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission considered the matter at its public meeting held on December 16, 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commission that the amended rules are **ELIGIBLE** for adoption and final filing.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the rules are **ADOPTED** and staff is authorized and directed to **FINAL FILE** them in accordance with R.C. Chapter 119.
