

3772-19-10 Maintenance and malfunctions.

(A) A casino operator must report to the commission, within fifteen minutes of initial discovery, that ~~If surveillance equipment that is critical to the casino operator's ability to meet any of the requirements of this chapter becomes out of service due to malfunction, it must be reported to the commission within fifteen minutes of initial discovery.~~

(B) Casino gaming in the affected area(s) shall cease to the extent ordered by the executive director until the casino operator provides adequate live monitoring by the surveillance department. ~~If, as a result of this malfunction, the commission deems the live monitoring by surveillance department is inadequate, casino gaming in the affected area(s) shall cease until the casino operator provides adequate monitoring.~~

(C) Routine maintenance of surveillance equipment must be completed without compromising any of the surveillance coverage provided by the surveillance system.
