

3772-19-02 Responsibilities of the surveillance department.

~~(A) Each casino operator must maintain and operate in the casino facility a surveillance system in accordance with~~make available to the commission ~~the specifications of this rule and as approved by the commission. The surveillance system shall provide access and override access to the commission.~~following items:

~~(C) At any time and without notice, the casino surveillance system, and its component parts, shall be subject to testing by the commission.~~

~~(D) Upon good cause shown, the commission may, at its discretion, grant a waiver from compliance with any surveillance requirement. All requests for waivers must be in writing and state the reasons for the request and the alternative measures that the casino operator will undertake to accomplish the objectives of the surveillance requirements. The casino operator must comply with the surveillance requirements approved by the commission while the request for waiver is pending. The commission may impose additional terms or requirements as a condition of granting a waiver.~~

3772-19-02 Surveillance plan.

~~(A) A casino operator must submit a surveillance plan to the commission for approval at least sixty days before the commencement of casino gaming. The surveillance plan must include the following~~

~~(1) An interactive electronic floor plan of the casino facility that shows the placement of all surveillance equipment; in and around the casino facility and all gaming equipment on the gaming floor;~~

~~(2) A detailed description of the all surveillance system and its equipment components;~~

~~(3) The procedures utilized for operation of the casino surveillance department;~~

~~(4) Staffing plans;~~

~~(5) Plans for monitoring security detention rooms;~~

~~(6) A list of personnel authorized to access the casino surveillance room;~~

~~(7) A list of persons or positions authorized by the director of surveillance to access the surveillance viewing room.~~

~~(78) The surveillance retention schedule, evidencing that all cameras are set for a retention period pursuant to this chapter; and~~

~~(98) Any other information the commission deems necessary.~~

~~(B) Alterations related to the operation of the surveillance plan, including department as requested by the executive director.~~

~~(B) The surveillance department must receive and monitor open-door alerts for all slot machines.~~

~~(C) Surveillance system changes modifications and upgrades, shall be submitted to the commission executive director for approval. The request to alter the surveillance plan must include details of the change, including a copy of the applicable areas of~~

~~(D) At any time and without notice, the casino facility floor plan and the reason for the change.~~

~~(C) A casino operator shall not commence casino gaming until the surveillance plans system shall be subject to audit or alterations are approved other testing by the commission and changes in coverage are examined and approved by the commission or the commission's agent.~~

~~(D) A casino operator shall maintain a copy of its current surveillance plan in the surveillance department and make the plan immediately available to the commission upon request.~~
