- ~~(A) Upon a determination by the commission that an applicant for an initial casino operator license is eligible to be issued a license, the applicant shall pay an upfront, nonrefundable license fee of fifty million dollars for each casino facility.~~
- ~~(B) Except as provided in division (B) of section 3772.17 of the Revised Code, upon a determination by the commission that an applicant for a new casino operator, management company, or holding company license is eligible to be issued a license, the applicant shall pay a nonrefundable license fee of one million five hundred thousand dollars for each casino facility.~~
- ~~(C) Except as provided in division (B) of section 3772.17 of the Revised Code, upon a determination by the commission that an applicant for a renewal casino operator, management company, or holding company license is eligible to be issued a license, the applicant shall pay a nonrefundable license fee of one million five hundred thousand dollars for each casino facility.~~
- ~~(D) All fees shall be submitted in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or electronic funds transfer payable to the treasurer of the state of Ohio.~~
