

Rule 3772-10-22 | Tips and gratuities.

~~(A) Licensed employee's may not solicit any tip or gratuity from any patron of the casino facility.~~

~~(A) Licensed employee's Each casino operator's internal controls shall detail the procedures for handling tips and gratuities.~~

~~(B) No licensed employee who is acting in a supervisory capacity may not shall solicit or accept, and no licensed casino gaming employee shall solicit, any tip or gratuity from any player or patron of the casino facility where he or she is employed. The casino operator shall not permit any practices prohibited by this rule.~~

~~(C) All tips and gratuities allowed to be given to table game dealers must shall be deposited in a transparent locked box reserved for such purpose. The~~

~~(D)(C) All tips and/or gratuities must shall be accounted for and placed in a pool for distribution, pro rata, among the table game dealers, unless the tips and except that there may be separate procedures for collecting gratuities are given to the casino employees during the conduct of a player against player contesteontests.~~
