**NOVEMBER 17, 2021 FINAL ORDER**  
**CLOSING SKILL-BASED AMUSEMENT MACHINE LICENSE APPLICATION**

On August 21, 2018, Cindy Lucky 7’s, LLC (“Cindy Lucky 7’s”) filed a Type-C Skill-Based Amusement Machine Operator License Application (“Application”) with the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”). Cindy Lucky 7’s then failed to cooperate with the Commission throughout the course of its investigation by not providing necessary information, even after being notified to do so. As a result, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (“Notice”) to Cindy Lucky 7’s.

Cindy Lucky 7’s investigation could have been continued if the requested information had been submitted. Further, pursuant to R.C. 119.07 and 3772.04, upon proper service, Cindy Lucky 7’s had the right to a hearing if requested within 30 days of the Notice’s mailing. Having properly served Cindy Lucky 7’s without receiving a request for a hearing during the statutorily prescribed time period, no hearing was held and the matter was brought before the Commission on November 17, 2021 for final adjudication. R.C. 119.07 and 3772.04(A).

The matters are now before the Commission for final adjudication.

**WHEREFORE**, the Commission **FINDS** and **CONCLUDES**:

Cindy Lucky 7’s failed to cooperate with the Commission throughout the course of the investigation, as set forth in the Notice.

**WHEREFORE**, the Commission **ORDERS**:

- 1) Cindy Lucky 7’s previously filed Application is **CLOSED** for failure to comply with the law.
- 2) This Order constitutes a **FINAL DETERMINATION** for purposes of Ohio Adm.Code 3772-50-09(C), thereby rendering any associated Skill-Based Amusement Machine Registration ineffective.

- 3) This Order **PROHIBITS** Cindy Lucky 7's from starting or continuing to operate in any capacity or manner that requires a license under Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 3772-50.
- 4) A certified copy of this Order will be served upon Cindy Lucky 7's, via certified mail, return receipt requested, and their counsel of record, if any, via ordinary mail.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**

**NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS**

Each Party is hereby notified that pursuant to R.C. 119.12, the Commission Order may be appealed by filing a Notice of Appeal with the Commission setting forth the Order that the Party is appealing from and stating that the Commission's Order is not supported by reliable, probative, and substantial evidence and is not in accordance with law. The Notice of Appeal may also include, but is not required to include, the specific grounds for the appeal. The Notice of Appeal must also be filed with the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas in accordance with R.C. 119.12. In filing the Notice of Appeal with the Commission or court, the notice that is filed may be either the original Notice of Appeal or a copy thereof. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 15 days after the date of mailing of the Commission Order.
