**JULY 21, 2021 FINAL ORDER**  
**CLOSING SKILL-BASED AMUSEMENT MACHINE LICENSE APPLICATIONS**

Each registered applicant listed in the attached Appendix (“Registered Applicant”) filed a Skill-Based Amusement Machine License Application (“Application”) with the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”). Each Registered Applicant identified at least one Skill-Based Amusement Machine Key Employee (“Key Employee”) that has not applied for a license. Each Registered Applicant was notified numerous times that the Commission required submission of the Key Employee’s application in order to continue the suitability investigation.

Each Registered Applicant’s suitability investigation could have continued if the missing Key Employee application had been submitted. Further, pursuant to R.C. 119.07 and 3772.04, upon proper service, each Registered Applicant had the right to a hearing if requested within 30 days of the Notice’s mailing. Having properly served each without receiving a request for a hearing during the statutorily prescribed time period, no hearings were held and the matters were brought before the Commission on April 15, 2020, for final adjudication. R.C. 119.07 and 3772.04(A).

**WHEREFORE**, the Commission **FINDS** and **CONCLUDES** as follows:

Each Registered Applicant failed to submit at least one Key Employee application, as required by Ohio law.

**WHEREFORE**, the Commission **ORDERS** as follows with respect to each Registered Applicant:

- 1) The previously filed Application is **CLOSED** for failure to comply with the law.
- 2) This Order constitutes a **FINAL DETERMINATION** for purposes of Ohio Adm.Code 3772-50-09(C), thereby rendering any associated Skill-Based Amusement Machine Registration ineffective.
- 3) This Order **PROHIBITS** those affected from starting or continuing to operate in any capacity or manner that requires a license under Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 3772-50.

- 4) A certified copy of this Order will be served upon those affected, via certified mail, return receipt requested, and their counsel of record, if any, via ordinary mail.

**NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS**

The Party is hereby notified that pursuant to R.C. 119.12, the Commission Order may be appealed by filing a Notice of Appeal with the Commission setting forth the Order that the Party is appealing from and stating that the Commission's Order is not supported by reliable, probative, and substantial evidence and is not in accordance with law. The Notice of Appeal may also include, but is not required to include, the specific grounds for the appeal. The Notice of Appeal must also be filed with the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas in accordance with R.C. 119.12. In filing the Notice of Appeal with the Commission or court, the notice that is filed may be either the original Notice of Appeal or a copy thereof. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 15 days after the date of mailing of the Commission Order.
