**SEPTEMBER 15, 2021 FINAL ORDER**  
**CLOSING SKILL-BASED AMUSEMENT MACHINE LICENSE APPLICATIONS**

The registered applicants listed in the attached Appendix (“Registered Applicants”) timely filed Skill-Based Amusement Machine License Applications (“Applications”) with the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”). They then failed to cooperate with the Commission throughout the course of its investigations by not providing necessary information, even after being notified to do so. As a result, the Commission issued Notices of Opportunity for Hearing (“Notices”) to each of them.

Upon proper service of the Notices, the Registered Applicants each had the right to a hearing if timely requested. None of them having done so, no hearings were held.

The matters are now before the Commission for final adjudication.

**WHEREFORE**, the Commission **FINDS** and **CONCLUDES**:

The Registered Applicants failed to cooperate with the Commission throughout the course of the investigations, as set forth in their Notices.

**WHEREFORE**, the Commission **ORDERS**:

- 1) The previously filed Applications are **CLOSED** for failure to comply with the law.
- 2) This Order constitutes a **FINAL DETERMINATION** for purposes of Ohio Adm.Code 3772-50-09(C), thereby rendering any associated Skill-Based Amusement Machine Registration ineffective.
- 3) This Order **PROHIBITS** those affected from starting or continuing to operate in any capacity or manner that requires a license under Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 3772-50.
- 4) A certified copy of this Order will be served upon those affected, via certified mail, return receipt requested, and their counsel of record, if any, via ordinary mail.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**

**NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS**

Each Party is hereby notified that pursuant to R.C. 119.12, the Commission Order may be appealed by filing a Notice of Appeal with the Commission setting forth the Order that the Party is appealing from and stating that the Commission's Order is not supported by reliable, probative, and substantial evidence and is not in accordance with law. The Notice of Appeal may also include, but is not required to include, the specific grounds for the appeal. The Notice of Appeal must also be filed with the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas in accordance with R.C. 119.12. In filing the Notice of Appeal with the Commission or court, the notice that is filed may be either the original Notice of Appeal or a copy thereof. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 15 days after the date of mailing of the Commission Order.
