RESOLUTION 2021-12

NO-CHANGE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES FILING

WHEREAS, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”);

WHEREAS, R.C. 3772.03 requires or authorizes the Commission to adopt administrative rules pursuant to R.C. Chapter 119 to complete the functions stated in R.C. Chapters 3772 and 3774;

WHEREAS, pursuant to this authority, the Commission adopted the following rules:

- 3772-2-08 Definitions;
- 3772-2-09 Procedures for accessing confidential personal information; and
- 3772-2-12 Restricting and logging access to confidential personal information in computerized personal information systems;

WHEREAS, in accordance with R.C. 106.03, the Commission reviewed these rules to determine, among other things, whether they should continue in their current form or should be amended or rescinded;

WHEREAS, if the Commission determines that the rules should continue in their current forms, R.C. 106.031 sets forth the procedure for filing them as no-change rules; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the matter at its public meeting held on March 17, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that the rules should continue in their current form and should be **FILED** as no-change rules.
