

OHIO CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION

RESOLUTION 2021-40

**BMM NORTH AMERICA, INC.’S REQUEST TO RENEW ITS  
CERTIFICATION AS AN INDEPENDENT TESTING LABORATORY  
FOR SKILL-BASED AMUSEMENT MACHINES**

**WHEREAS**, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”);

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 3772.03(K) grants the Commission jurisdiction over all persons conducting or participating in the conduct of skill-based amusement machine operations authorized by R.C. Chapters 2915 and 3772;

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Adm.Code 3772-50-21 permits an independent testing laboratory to request certification to scientifically test and technically evaluate skill-based machines and equipment for compliance with R.C. Chapters 2915 and 3772 and the rules adopted thereunder;

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Adm.Code 3772-50-21 through -23 establish the requirements, conditions, and duties of certification;

**WHEREAS**, BMM North America, Inc. dba BMM Testlabs (“BMM”) has timely submitted a request to renew its certification as an independent testing laboratory for skill-based amusement machines and equipment, which included the required information and fee; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission reviewed all submitted materials and information and considered the matter at its public meeting on September 15, 2021.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commission that BMM is **QUALIFIED** and **ELIGIBLE** for certification to scientifically test and technically evaluate skill-based amusement machines and equipment for compliance with R.C. Chapters 2915 and 3772 and the rules adopted thereunder.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that BMM’s request to renew its certification as an independent testing laboratory of skill-based amusement machines and equipment is **APPROVED** and BMM’s certification is **RENEWED** for a period of three years, effective upon the expiration date of its previous certification, subject to continued compliance with R.C. Chapters 2915 and 3772 and the rules adopted thereunder.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Resolution 2021-40 does not in any way

affect, negate, or otherwise absolve BMM from its obligations to comply with R.C. Chapters 2915 and 3772 and the rules adopted thereunder and all other conditions imposed by the Commission through resolution or otherwise.

***BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED*** that Resolution 2021-40 does not restrict or limit the Commission's future exercise of authority and discretion with respect to imposing additional conditions or taking further action upon BMM under R.C. Chapters 2915 and 3772 and the rules adopted thereunder.
