RESOLUTION 2021-43

**DELEGATE AUTHORITY TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ADMINISTER, MAINTAIN, AND UPDATE THE AGENCY'S DISQUALIFYING OFFENSE LIST**

**WHEREAS**, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission ("Commission");

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 3772.03 authorizes the Commission to ensure the integrity of casino gaming, skill-based amusement machines, and fantasy contests through licensing, regulating, investigating, and penalizing all persons under its jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 3772.06 mandates that the Commission appoint an Executive Director who is the agency's Chief Executive Officer;

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Adm.Code 3772-2-05, 3772-50-02, and 3772-74-02 authorize the Commission, in its discretion and where permitted by law, to delegate its authority to perform any of its functions to the Executive Director; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission considered this matter at its public meeting on October 20, 2021.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commission that the Executive Director may be and hereby is delegated the authority to administer, maintain, and update the initial list of disqualifying offenses adopted by the agency pursuant to and in accordance with H.B. 263 of the 133rd General Assembly, also known as the Fresh Start Act.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Commission maintains the authority to review any decision made or action taken pursuant to this delegation as well as the authority to make any such decision or take any such action if it so chooses or upon request of the Executive Director.
