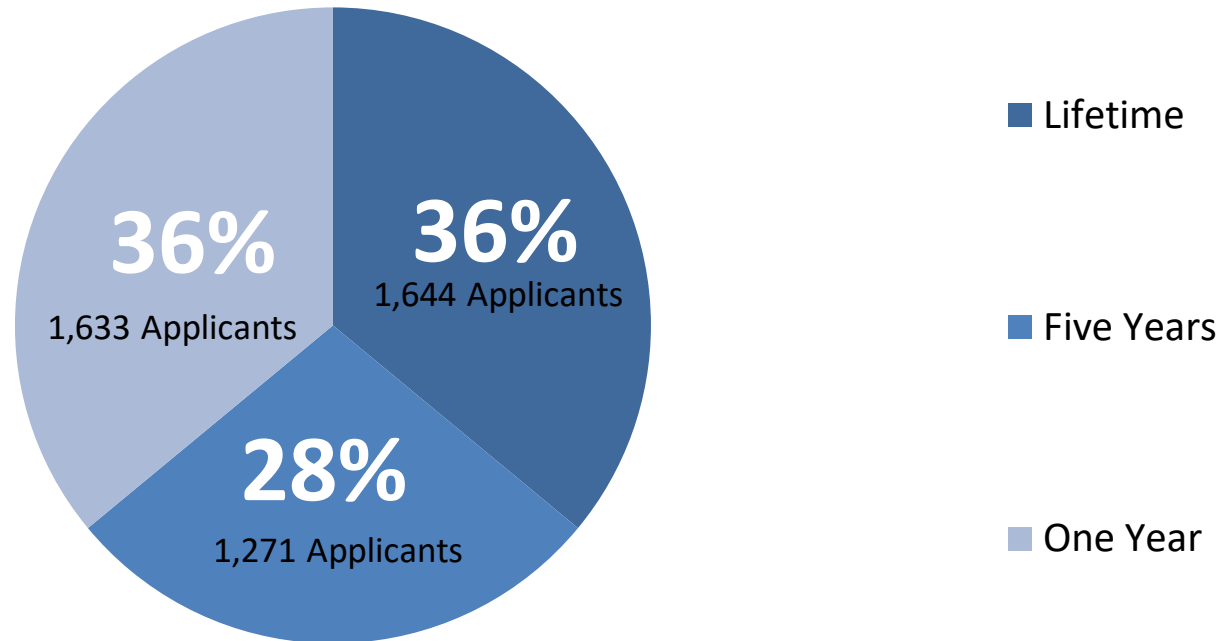


Ohio Voluntary Exclusion Program

As of November 4, 2022, the Ohio VEP has accepted 7,178 applications from residents in 34 states as well as internationally for the voluntary exclusion program. There are currently 4,548 active program participants.

Length of Time of Exclusion by Active Participants



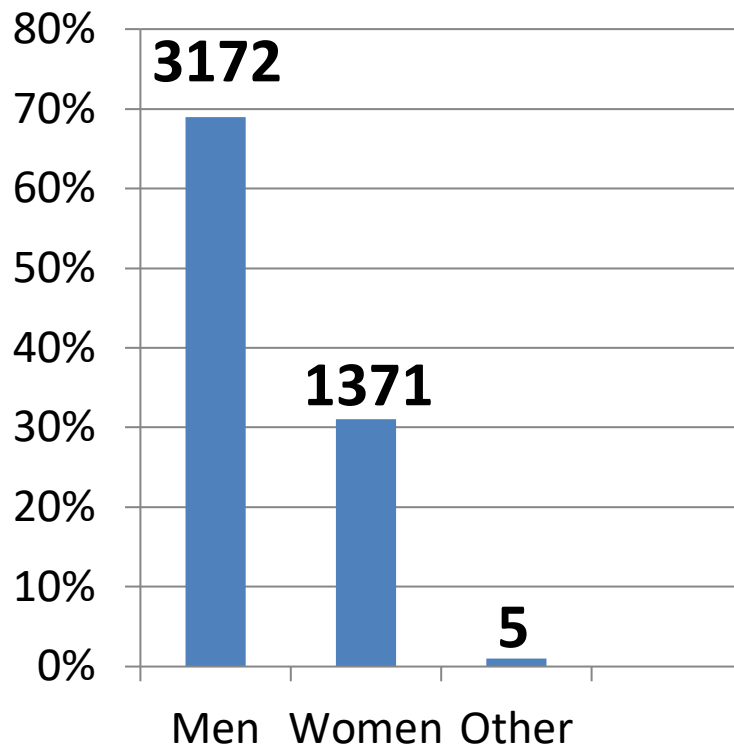

Enrollment as of November 4, 2022

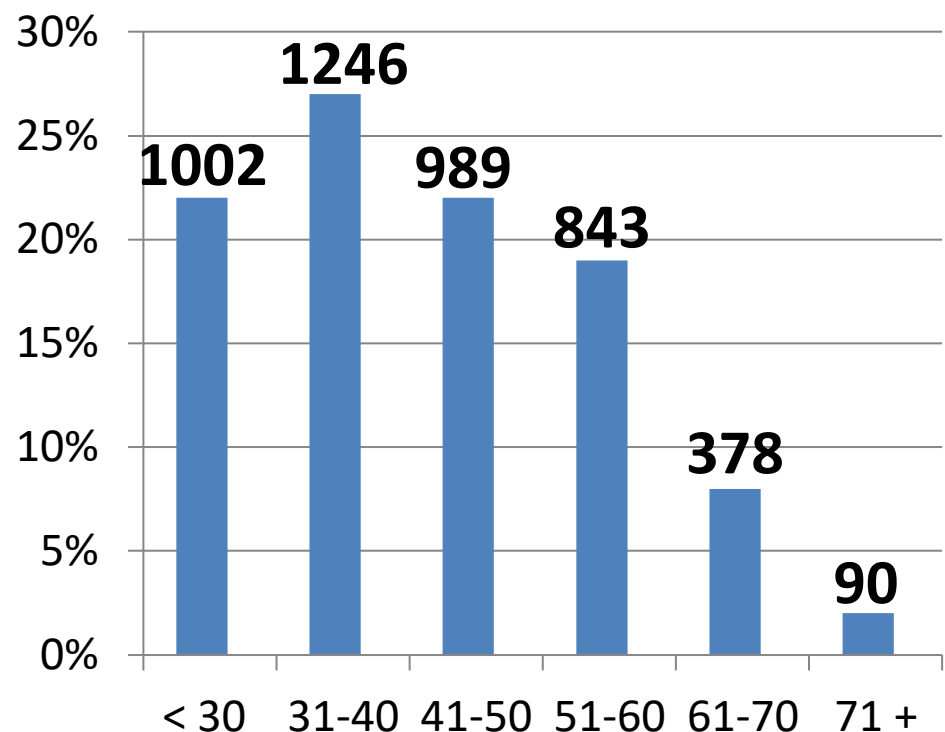

By Gender

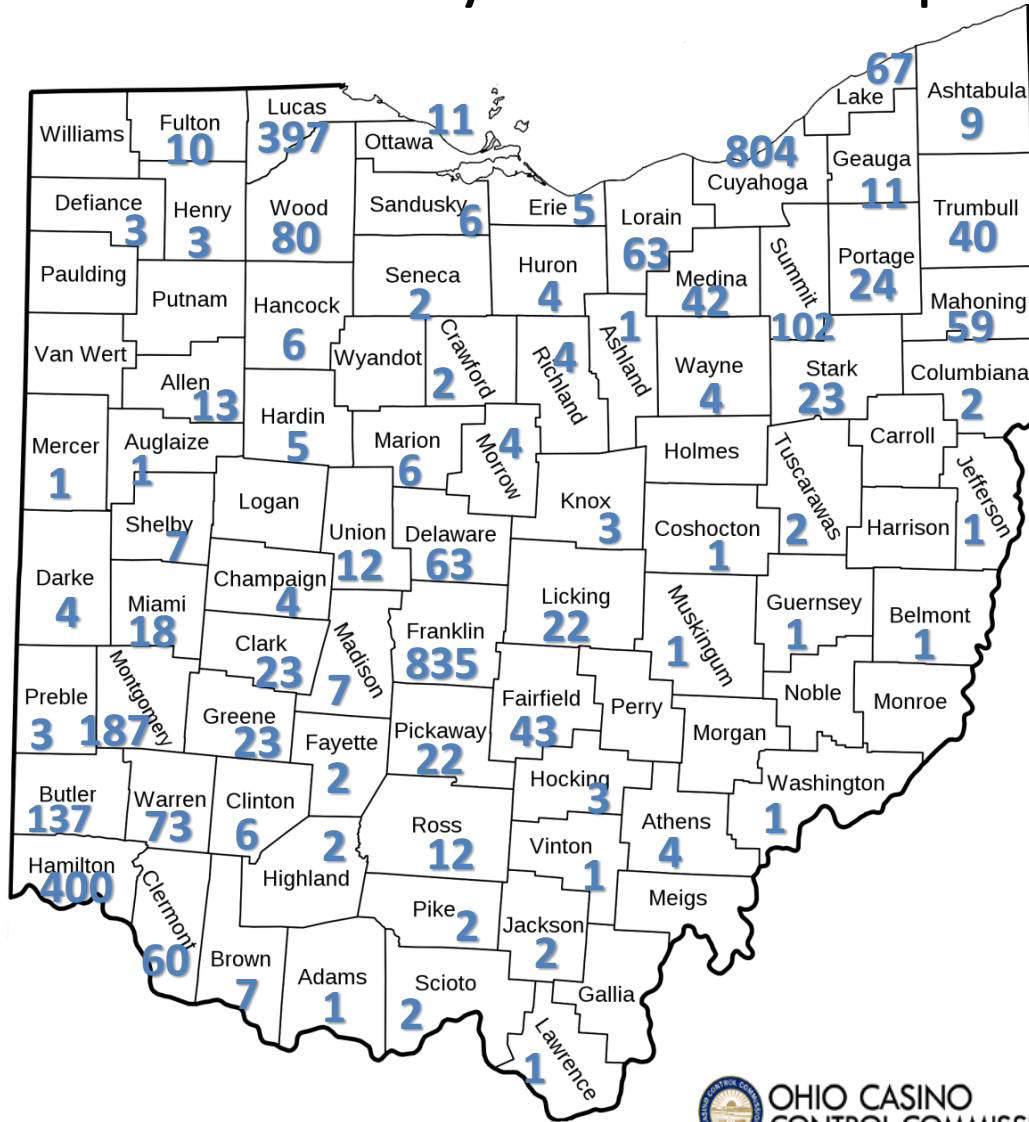


By Age

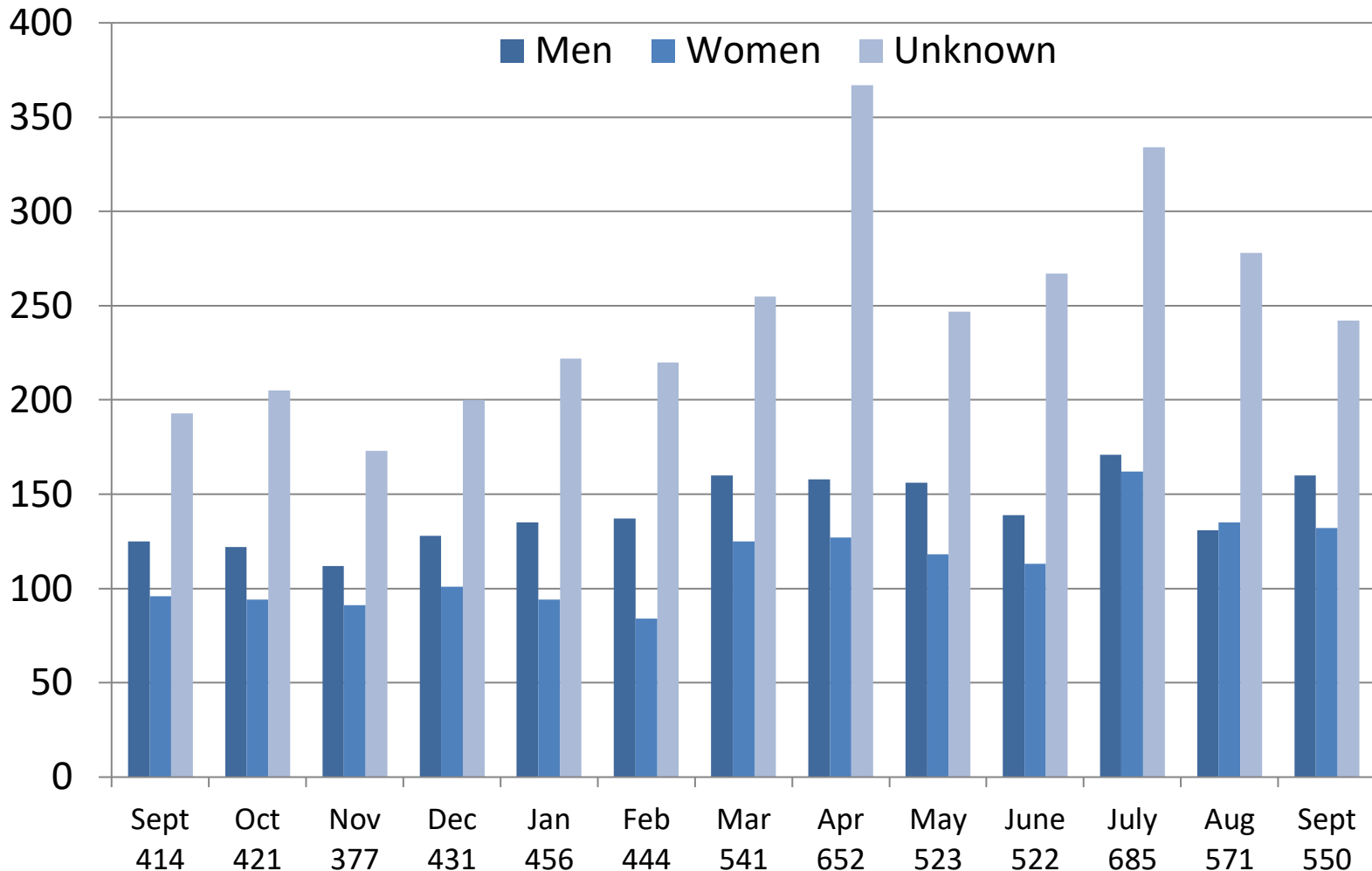

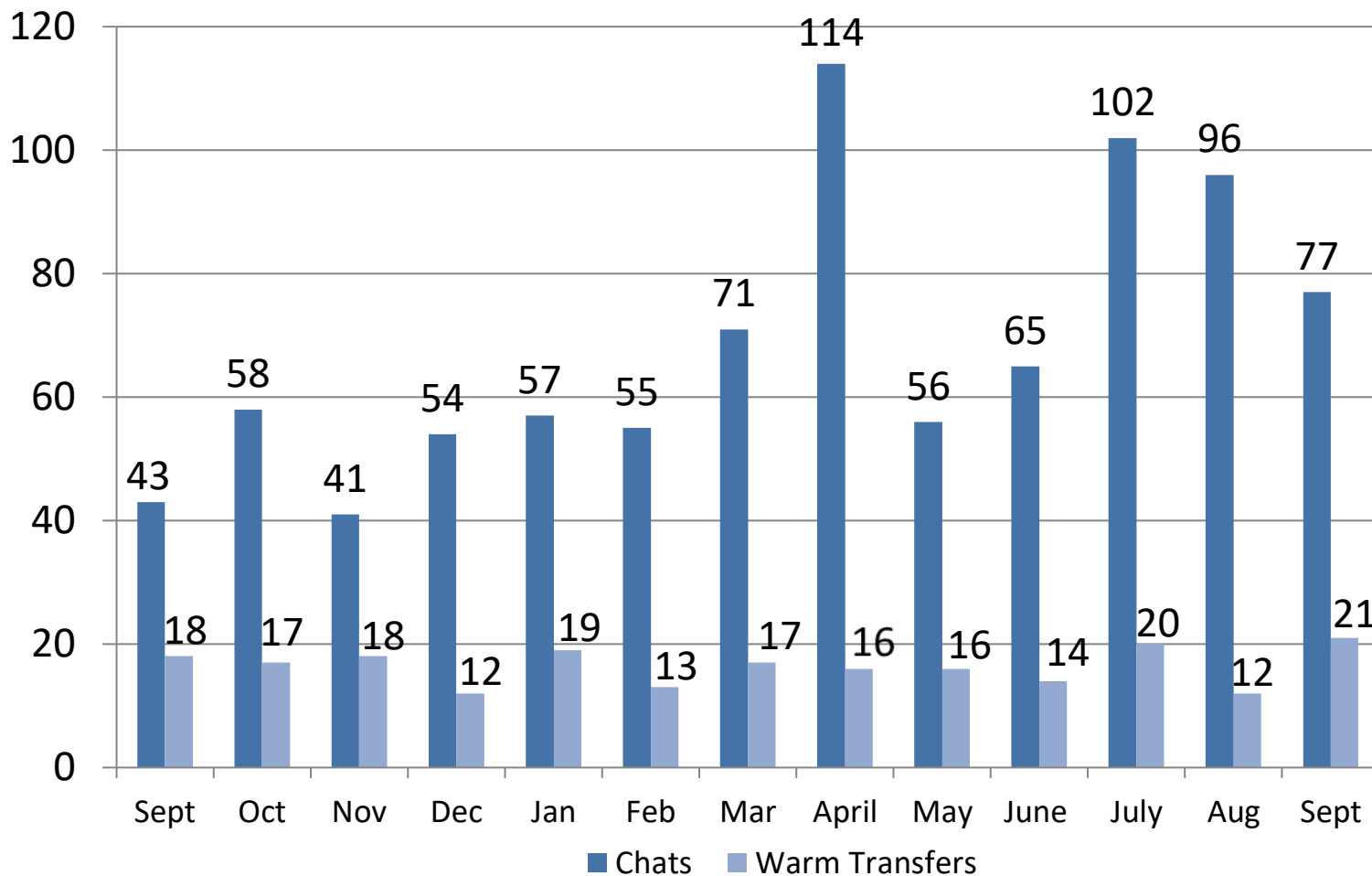
Problem Gambling Helpline Calls
